2 To amend and reenact R.S. 33:2345(B), relative to municipal chiefs of police; to provide for 3 training requirements for each municipal chief of police; to change the training hours 4 required relative to continuing education; and to provide for related matters. 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 6 Section 1. Beginning January 1, 2004 2015, each municipal chief of police shall be 10 required to complete twenty-four twelve hours of continuing education as approved 11 by the board within every twenty-four-month period calendar year. 12

Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Judiciary to the original bill.

1. Changed the education requirements <u>from</u> 12 hours in a 12-month period <u>to</u> 12 hours every calendar year.
