CAPITAL OUTLAY

OR NO IMPACT EX See Note

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Requires line item appropriations for non-governmental entities in the capital outlay bill to be listed in a separate schedule and requires the date the application was received to be included in the project title.

The proposed legislation requires the Division of Administration (DOA) to establish a separate schedule within the capital outlay budget that includes all line item appropriations for non-governmental (not-for-profit and for-profit) entities. The <u>present law</u> provides that the DOA shall certify the date and time when a capital outlay request is received. The proposed legislation retains the present law but further requires that the date certified by the DOA shall be included within the title of a non-governmental entity project that receives an appropriation in the capital outlay budget (HB 2).

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

According to the Office of Facility Planning & Control, the additional workload relative to changing the schedule number and associated project number for 184 existing non-governmental entity projects will be absorbed by existing staff.
