- Section 2. R.S. 40:1739.1.2. is hereby enacted to read as follows:
- 12 <u>§1379.1.2.</u> Carrying of concealed handguns by members and officers of the legislature
- A. Notwithstanding any other provision of law or ordinance to the contrary, except Subsection C of this Section, a member or officer of either house of the
- legislature who meets the requirements of Subsection B of this Section may carry a concealed handgun on his person anywhere in the state, including any
- place open to the public.
- 19 B. In order to exercise the authority set forth in Subsection A of this Section, the member or officer must:
- 21 (1) Possess a current statewide concealed handgun permit pursuant to R.S. 40:1379.3.
- 23 (2) Possess identification which contains photographic identification and identifies the individual as a member or officer of either house of the legislature.
- (3) Be annually certified in the use of firearms by the Council on Peace Officer
  Standards and Training and possess proof of such certification.
- 27 <u>C. Subsection A of this Section shall not authorize the possession of a concealed handgun:</u>
- 29 (1) In any facility, building, location, zone, or area in which firearms are banned by federal law.
- 31 (2) In any courtroom.
- 32 (3) In any facility, building, location, zone, or area in which a concealed 33 handgun permit does not authorize or entitle a permittee to carry a concealed 34 handgun pursuant to R.S. 40:1379.3(N)(1), (2), (4), (7), (8), (9), (10), or (11)
- 35 <u>except as provided in Subsection D of this Section.</u>
- D. Notwithstanding R.S. 40:1379.3(N)(10), a member or officer authorized pursuant to Subsection B of this Section may possess a handgun on his person on the premises of an alcohol beverage outlet which has been issued a Class A-Restaurant permit, as defined in Part II of Chapter 1 or Part II of Chapter
- 40 **2** of Title 26 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950."
