12	Art. 1734.1. Cash deposit; procedure
13	A. When the case has been set for trial, the court may order, in lieu of the
14	bond required in Article 1734, a non-refundable deposit for costs, which shall be a
15	specific cash amount, and the court shall fix the time for making the deposit, which
16	shall be no later than thirty days prior to trial. The deposit shall include sufficient
17	funds for payment of all costs associated with a jury trial, including juror fees and
18	expenses and charges of the jury commission, clerk of court, and sheriff. The
19	required deposit shall not exceed two four thousand dollars for the first day and four
20	hundred one thousand dollars per day for each additional day the court estimates the
21	trial will last. Notice of the fixing of the deposit shall be served on all parties. If the
22	deposit is not timely made, any other party shall have an additional ten days to make
23	the required deposit. Failure to post the cash deposit shall constitute a waiver of a
24	trial by jury. However, no cash deposit shall be required of an applicant for a jury
25	trial under the provisions of this Article if waived or an order is rendered, pursuant
26	to Chapter 5 of Title I of Book IX of the Code of Civil Procedure, permitting the
27	applicant to litigate or continue to litigate without payment of costs in advance or
28	furnishing security therefor.
