Present law provides that specially designated commissioned Louisiana state police officers assigned to intelligence, detectives, narcotics, or internal affairs, and commissioned agents of the office of alcohol beverage control shall have the power to administer oaths and receive sworn statements, in connection with their official duties.

Proposed law retains present law and adds specially designated commissioned officers of the office of the state fire marshal as persons who have the power to administer oaths and receive sworn statements, in connection with their official duties.
