COURTS/COURT COSTS: Requires the levy of a warrant recall fee to fund a misdemeanor jail in East Baton Rouge Parish

AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 13:1000.10, 1415, 2071.1, 2488.40, and Part X of Chapter 7 of Title 13 of the 3 Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, to be comprised of R.S. 13:2489.1, relative to 4 collection of fees in all East Baton Rouge Parish courts; to require all courts in East 5 Baton Rouge Parish to levy a warrant recall fee to fund a misdemeanor detention 6 facility; to provide for the collection of the fee and expenditure of funds collected; 7 to provide reporting requirements; and to provide for related matters. 8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 9 Section 1. R.S. 13:1000.10, 1415, 2071.1, 2488.40, and Part X of Chapter 7 of Title 10 13 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 13:2489.1, are hereby 11 enacted to read as follows: 12 §1000.10. Nineteenth Judicial District Court; additional warrant recall fees; 13 Misdemeanor Detention Fund 14 A. The Nineteenth Judicial District Court shall levy and impose a warrant 15 recall fee of fifty dollars on all persons who fail to appear as ordered on all 16 misdemeanor offenses and traffic offenses where a warrant for arrest is issued, the 17 proceeds of which shall be used to pay the expenses of operating a misdemeanor 18 detention facility in the parish. 19 B. The clerk of court shall place all sums collected or received pursuant to this Section with the finance director for the parish of East Baton Rouge, who shall 20

traffic offenses where a warrant for arrest is issued, the proceeds of which shall
used to pay the expenses of operating a misdemeanor detention facility in the paris
B. The clerk of court shall place all sums collected or received pursuant
this Section with the finance director for the parish of East Baton Rouge, who sh
place the funds in a separate account to be designated as the Misdemeanor Detenti

Alfred Williams HB No. 915

Abstract: Requires the collection of a \$50 warrant recall fee in all courts within East Baton Rouge Parish and provides for the collection and use of such fee.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the 19th JDC, East Baton Rouge Parish Family Court, Baker City Court, Zachary City Court, and Baton Rouge City Court to levy and impose a \$50 warrant recall fee on all persons who fail to appear as ordered on all misdemeanor offenses and traffic offenses where a warrant for arrest is issued and provides that the proceeds of which shall be used to pay the expenses of operating a misdemeanor detention facility in the parish.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires each clerk of court to place all sums collected or received with the finance director for the parish of East Baton Rouge, who shall place the funds in a separate account to be designated as the Misdemeanor Detention Fund.

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<u>Proposed law</u> requires all monies in this account to be used solely for the purpose of paying expenses associated with the operation of a misdemeanor detention facility in the parish and requires the finance director to conduct an annual audit of the fund and the books and related accounts and file the audit with the office of the legislative auditor, where it shall be available for public inspection.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires all law enforcement agencies within the parish to confer for the purpose of creating and implementing additional pilot programs for the periodic targeted enforcement of outstanding warrants until sufficient revenues are generated to sustain the permanent operation of the misdemeanor detention facility.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the mayor-president to expend funds and enter into cooperative endeavor agreements with all courts, the sheriff of East Baton Rouge Parish, and all other law enforcement agencies within the parish in order to carry out the provisions of <u>proposed law</u>, subject to the approval of the Metropolitan Council.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the mayor-president through the finance department to report quarterly to the Metropolitan council and the courts within the parish on the misdemeanor detention fund, including recommendations regarding necessary adjustments and the financial feasibility of the misdemeanor warrant enforcement programs.
