12	executive director is able to assume the daily responsibilities of the executive
13	director.
14	B. The positions of executive director and assistant executive director shall be
15	filled by the board within six months after this Section becomes effective.
16	C. Neither the executive director nor the assistant executive director shall be
17	a member of the board. The executive director and assistant executive director
18	shall each be a full-time unclassified employee of the board who shall be paid
19	compensation in an amount to be determined by the board which shall be
20	comparable to like positions with levee districts throughout the state."
