## SENATE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

- 2 On page 1, at the beginning of line 11, change "J.(1)" to "J."
- 3 AMENDMENT NO. 2
- 4 On page 1, at the end of line 11, insert a colon ":"
- 5 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 3</u>
- 6 On page 1, delete lines 12 through 16 and insert the following:
- "(1) Prohibit a bus driver from loading or unloading students at school while the bus is in a traffic lane of any type of street as defined in R.S.
   32:1 and require that students be loaded or unloaded on a shoulder, in a school parking lot, or at other appropriate off-road location at the school as determined by the school governing authority. The requirements of this Paragraph shall not apply if the"
- 13 AMENDMENT NO. 4
- On page 1, between lines 19 and 20, insert the following:
- "(2) Prohibit a bus driver from loading or unloading students at or near their homes while the bus is in a traffic lane of any type of street as defined in R.S. 32:1 and require that students be loaded or unloaded on a shoulder. However, if there is no shoulder, a bus driver may load and unload a student while the bus is in a lane of traffic but only if the bus is in the lane farthest to the right side of the road so that the student does not need to cross any lane of traffic to get onto or off of the bus.
- 22 (3) Prohibit a bus driver from loading or unloading students either at
  23 school or at or near their homes in a manner or in a location that results in
  24 students crossing lanes of traffic on a state highway or any other type of
  25 street."
