- "a dispute assessment meeting shall be held in which all of the parties and principals who are authorized to make decisions regarding settlement shall discuss all of the issues involved in the litigation and any other matters needed to evaluate the claim. The parties or principals who are authorized to make decisions regarding settlement may attend the meeting by use of telephone conference call, videoconferencing, or other similar telecommunication methods.
