**Subject:** Electronic cigarettes and vapor products

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Prohibits the sale of electronic cigarettes and vapor products to persons under the age of eighteen

<u>Present law</u> prohibits the distribution of sample tobacco products to persons under the age of 18 years. <u>Proposed law</u> adds alternative nicotine products and vapor products to the <u>present law</u> prohibition. Defines alternative nicotine product and vapor product. <u>Present law</u> provides in order to prevent persons under the age of 18 years of age from purchasing or receiving tobacco products from vending machines or self-service displays, the sale or delivery of tobacco products through a vending machine or self-service display is prohibited. <u>Proposed law</u> adds alternative nicotine products and vapor products to the <u>present law</u> prohibitions. <u>Present law</u> provides that the sale of tobacco products to a minor by a retail dealer's agent, associate, employee, representative, or servant is considered an act of the retail dealer except under certain circumstances. <u>Proposed law</u> adds alternative nicotine products and vapor products to the coverage of <u>present law</u>. Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
