Present law provides that an insurer and insured may agree to exclude named persons from coverage of a policy of motor vehicle liability insurance. Proposed law provides that the named insured of a motor vehicle and the operator who has been excluded from coverage shall be solidarily liable for the damages caused by the operator's negligence or intentional acts that occur as a result of his operation of the vehicle. Proposed law applies only when the named insured provides express permission to the excluded driver to operate the vehicle. Proposed law limits the liability that can be attributed to the named insured to the minimum required as provided by R.S. 23:900, unless that named insured is the parent or tutor of, is vicariously liable for, or is responsible for acts of omission of the excluded driver. Proposed law provides that the insurer shall not be liable for bodily injury, loss or damage under any coverage of the policy if the operator was properly excluded as set forth by present law and that the insurer is not obligated to provide a defense or to pay the costs of defense.
