1 AN ACT 2 To amend and reenact R.S. 15:572.4(D), relative to pardons; to provide relative to 3 applications for pardons by persons serving a life sentence; to reduce the length of time the applicant is required to wait before filing a subsequent application after a 4 5 denial; and to provide for related matters. 6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 7 Section 1. R.S. 15:572.4(D) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: 8 §572.4. Board of Pardons; rules, regulations, and procedures; notice; restrictions on 9 applications; time periods for additional review 10 11 D. Notwithstanding any provisions of law to the contrary, any applicant who 12 has been sentenced to life imprisonment shall not be eligible to apply to the board 13 for a pardon or commutation of sentence for a period of fifteen years after being 14 sentenced by the trial court. If the application is denied, the applicant shall be 15 notified in writing of the reason for the denial and thereafter may file a new 16 application to the board no earlier than seven five years from the date of action by 17 the board. A third application shall not be filed earlier than five years from the date 18 of action taken by the board on the second application. Any subsequent applications 19 shall not be filed earlier than five years after the immediately preceding action taken 20 by the board. However, the provisions of this Subsection shall not apply when the 21 board determines that new and material evidence that, notwithstanding the exercise
