Proposed law retains present law and adds that all persons should be able to compete for available housing on an open, fair and equitable basis, regardless of whether a victim of domestic abuse. Proposed law provides that it shall be unlawful to discriminate based on whether a person is victim of domestic abuse regarding the following: refusal to sale or rent housing, residential real estate transactions, and brokerage services.
