## 1 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 1</u>

- 2 On page 3, line 7, after "2015," delete the remainder of the line and delete line 8 in its
- 3 entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:
- 4 "authorizes the same services for families experiencing homelessness as for other
- 5 low-income families. However, the plan does not account for the ways that
- 6 <u>eligibility requirements for homeless families function as a barrier which restricts</u>
- 7 <u>those families from ultimately receiving assistance."</u>
- 8 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 2</u>
- 9 On page 3, line 23, delete "prioritization of"
- 10 AMENDMENT NO. 3
- On page 3, at the end of line 24, insert "assistance"
- 12 AMENDMENT NO. 4
- On page 4, delete lines 4 and 5 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:
- "(2) Establish a grace period of a defined duration in which a homeless
- 15 <u>family is authorized to receive subsidized child care and to enroll a child in such care</u>
- pending submission of necessary entry documentation. The purpose of the grace
- period shall be to allow the family reasonable time to comply with requirements to
- 18 <u>submit a birth certificate and immunization records."</u>

- 20 On page 4, line 8, after "program" and before the period "." insert "for a period of not less
- 21 than ninety days from the date of their child's enrollment in child care"
