## **DIGEST**

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that a school bus driver knowingly operating a school bus without the required insurance shall be fined not less than \$500 nor more than \$1,000.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that if the owner of a school bus knowingly allows the school bus to be operated without the security required by <u>proposed law</u> he shall be fined not less than \$500 nor more than \$1,000.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that if a school bus operating without the security required by <u>proposed law</u> is involved in an accident, the owner shall be fined not less than \$500 nor more than \$1,000, the vehicle's registration will be revoked for 60 days, and the school bus driver's commercial driver's license shall be suspended for 1 year, if he had knowledge that the bus was uninsured.
