Subject: LA 4 donations

OR DECREASE GF EX See Note

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FUNDS/FUNDING Authorizes public or private entities to make certain donations to participating school systems for children enrolled in the Cecil J. Picard LA 4 Early Childhood Program classes. (7/1/14)

Proposed legislation authorizes any public or private entity, including any non-profit organization to make a directed donation to any participating school district for a student who is enrolled in the Cecil J. Picard LA 4 Early Childhood Program. Proposed amendments allow private businesses, industry, foundations charities and other groups to request from the Division of Administration that they create scholarship programs to make payments to participating school systems on behalf of individual students. Subject to DOA approval of the scholarship program any funds received by participating schools on behalf of the students would be credited against the dollar amount of any allocation to the school system. To the extent such payments are for an amount less than what the student would have received from the state, the school system shall receive the difference from the state. Further provides that the annual appropriation for the LA 4 program shall be reduced by the amount of scholarship funds actually received by participating schools. Effective July 1, 2014.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There will be an indeterminable reduction in state general fund expenditures in an amount equal to directed donations for participants in the LA 4 program. For FY 14, there are 16,283 4 year olds enrolled in the LA 4 program. Total funding is \$74.6 M (\$35.1 M SGF and \$39.5 M TANF) with an allocation of \$4,580 per student. As an example, if an organization donated the full allocation amount for 300 students there would be a reduction of \$1.4 M in state general funds (\$4,580 x 300= \$1,374,000). However, if the organization only donated \$2,000 per student for 300 students, the state would transfer \$774,000 to the schools for the difference ($$4,580-$2,000 =$2,580 \times 300=$774,000$); with a resulting SGF reduction of only \$626,000. The actual reduction amounts will depend upon the number of participating students and the amount of the scholarship donations received.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
