8	from high school shall be deemed eligible to receive an Opportunity Award,
9	provided that he meets the following qualifications:
10	(I) The student enrolls full-time in a qualifying postsecondary institution
11	within one year of high school graduation.
12	(II) At the end of the student's first year, he will have earned at least
13	twenty-four credit hours, excluding remedial courses, with at least a cumulative
14	grade point average of 3.50 on a 4.00 scale.
15	(III) Thereafter, the student shall meet all continuing program eligibility
16	requirements as prescribed in this Section for an Opportunity Award.
