3	of certain duties of a trustee; to provide that the delegation of authority for the sale
4	of immovable property under certain circumstances shall be considered a ministerial
5	duty; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 9:2087(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§2087. Delegating performance
9	* * *
10	B.(1) A trustee may, by power of attorney, delegate the performance of
11	ministerial duties and acts that he could not reasonably be required to perform
12	personally.
13	(2) A written power of attorney in authentic form, executed by a trustee
14	authorizing a mandatary to sell specifically described immovable property at a
15	specific price shall be considered the delegation of the performance of a ministerial
16	duty as provided by Paragraph (1) of this Subsection.
