HOUSE BILL NO. 638

BY REPRESENTATIVE CONNICK

AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 15:542.1.4(A)(1), relative to sex offender registration and notification requirements; to provide relative to the crime of failure to register and notify as a sex offender or child predator; to amend the crime of failure to register and notify as a sex offender or child predator to include untimely actions; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 15:542.1.4(A)(1) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§542.1.4. Failure to register and notify as a sex offender or child predator; penalties

A.(1) A person who fails to timely register, fails to timely provide any information required by the provisions of this Chapter, fails to timely and periodically renew and update registration as required by the provisions of this Chapter, fails to timely provide proof of residence, fails to timely provide or notification of change of address or other registration information, or fails to provide community notification as required by the provisions of this Chapter, and a person who knowingly provides false information to a law enforcement agency as provided in R.S. 15:542(C)(3), shall, upon first conviction, be fined not more than one
