3	notification requirements; to provide relative to the crime of failure to register and

5	and notify as a sex offender or child predator to include untimely actions; and to
6	provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 15:542.1.4(A)(1) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as
9	follows:
10	§542.1.4. Failure to register and notify as a sex offender or child predator; penalties
11	A.(1) A person who fails to timely register, fails to timely provide any
12	information required by the provisions of this Chapter, fails to timely and
13	periodically renew and update registration as required by the provisions of this
14	Chapter, fails to timely provide proof of residence, fails to timely provide or
15	notification of change of address or other registration information, or fails to provide
16	community notification as required by the provisions of this Chapter, and a person
17	who knowingly provides false information to a law enforcement agency as provided
18	in R.S. 15:542(C)(3), shall, upon first conviction, be fined not more than one

1	thousand dollars and imprisoned with hard labor for not less than two years nor more
2	than ten years without benefit of parole, probation, or suspension of sentence.
