16	Economic Development Corporation, and the Ascension Little Theater; and
17	WHEREAS, Mr. Diez became a Republican in 1972 when most Louisianians were
18	registered as affiliated with the Democratic Party, and actively and personally sought to
19	increase the membership in the Republican Party, including his efforts in sponsoring and
20	funding the very successful "Switch in 96" voter registration drive; and
