

SENATE BILL NO. 192

BY SENATOR MORRISH

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 32:388(B)(1)(b)(iv), relative to trucks hauling concrete or
3 construction aggregates; extends termination date for two years for ready-mixed
4 concrete trucks to exceed licensed gross vehicle weight under certain conditions; and
5 to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 32:388(B)(1)(b)(iv) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as
8 follows:

9 §388. Penalties; payments

13 (iv) Effective from August 1, 2012, through July 31, ~~2014~~ **2016**, no truck
14 hauling ready-mixed concrete shall be assessed a penalty for exceeding its maximum
15 permissible gross weight, as determined by law, provided the total excess weight is
16 ten percent or less of such truck's maximum permissible gross weight, such truck
17 contains a certificate evidencing its most recent mixer chip-out of build-up occurred
18 within the previous ninety days, such truck does not exceed the posted load while
19 crossing a posted bridge, such truck is not operating on the interstate system, and no
20 tire on such truck exceeds its tire weight rating. If such truck's total excess weight
21 is greater than ten percent of its maximum permissible gross weight, as determined
22 by law, such truck shall be assessed a penalty calculated on the total amount by
23 which the truck's weight exceeds its maximum permissible gross weight, as
24 determined by law. For the purposes of this Item, a "ready-mixed concrete truck"

1 is defined as a vehicle designed exclusively to transport or manufacture ready-mixed
2 concrete and includes a concrete pump truck engaged in hauling ready-mixed
3 concrete.
