Provides relative to the crimes of incest and aggravated incest

Present law provides for the crimes of incest, aggravated incest, crime against nature, and aggravated crime against nature.

Proposed law repeals the crime of incest and places the elements and penalties for the crime into the offense of crime against nature. Repeals the crime of aggravated incest and places the elements and penalties for the crime into the offense of aggravated crime against nature. Directs the Louisiana Law Institute to change all references in Louisiana law from “incest” to “crime against nature” and from “aggravated incest” to “aggravated crime against nature” to reflect the changes made.
