SCHOOLS. Requests DHH to study the most effective means to ensure the proper utilization of inhalers by school nurses and report to the Senate and House Committees on Health and Welfare.

1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2	To urge and request the Department of Health and Hospitals to study the most effective
3	means to ensure the proper utilization of inhalers by school nurses within schools in
4	Louisiana and to report its findings to the Senate Committee on Health and Welfare
5	and the House Committee on Health and Welfare.
6	WHEREAS, the use of inhalers by students in Louisiana schools has risen
7	dramatically over the last few years; and
8	WHEREAS, certain Louisiana schools have experienced students with increased
9	breathing problems; and
10	WHEREAS, the Legislature of Louisiana finds that ensuring the proper utilization
11	of inhalers in Louisiana schools by school nurses is an important public health priority for
12	the state.
13	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
14	urge and request the Department of Health and Hospitals to study the most effective means
15	to ensure the proper utilization of inhalers by school nurses in Louisiana schools and to
16	report its findings to the Senate Committee on Health and Welfare and the House Committee
17	on Health and Welfare.
18	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in conducting the study, the department may

11	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the department shall provide the findings of this
12	study in the form of a written report to the Senate Committee on Health and Welfare and the
13	House Committee on Health and Welfare on or before February 1, 2015.

15	secretary of the Department of Health and Hospitals and the state superintendent of
