20	Any person who is authorized to possess a firearm sound suppressor, as
21	<u>evidenced by payment and possession of the required federal tax stamp issued</u>
22	<u>by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, may use a firearm</u>
23	fitted with a sound suppressor when taking game birds, wild quadrupeds,
24	<u>outlaw quadrupeds, nutria, or beaver as provided by R.S. 56:116.1. Any person</u>
25	who has been convicted of a class four or greater hunting violation for a period
26	<u>of five years after the date of such conviction shall not use a firearm fitted with</u>
27	a sound suppressor pursuant to this Section. Possession or use of a sound
28	suppressor by a person other than as permitted by this Section shall be
29	considered in violation of this Section and shall be punished as a class six
30	violation in accordance with the provisions of R.S. 56:36."
