2	To amend and reenact R.S. 14:62.8(B)(2), relative to the crime of home invasion; to provide
3	a minimum sentence of five years imprisonment at hard labor for home invasion; and
4	to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 14:62.8(B)(2) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§62.8. Home invasion
8	* * *
9	B.(1) * * * *
10	(2) Whoever commits the crime of home invasion while armed with a
11	dangerous weapon shall be fined not more than seven thousand dollars and shall be
12	imprisoned at hard labor for not less than five years nor more than thirty years.
13	* * *
14	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
15	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
16	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
17	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
18	effective on the day following such approval.
