SB No. 212

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the use of a firearm fitted with a sound suppressor in hunting outlaw quadrupeds, nutria, or beaver.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and expands the authorization to hunt with a firearm fitted with a sound suppressor to game birds and all wild quadrupeds, which includes outlaw quadrupeds, nutria, and beaver.

<u>Present law</u> limits hunting with a sound suppressor to a person authorized to possess such firearm fitted with a sound suppressor, as evidenced by possession of the federal tax stamp required by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives. Prohibits use of a sound suppressor by any person convicted of a hunting violation class four or greater for five years after the date of conviction.

Proposed law retains present law.

Effective August 1, 2014.
