## HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

House Bill No. 864 by Representative Talbot

MTR VEHICLE/COMPULS INS: Creates a penalty for school bus drivers operating buses without insurance

	Synopsis of Senate Amendments
1.	Adds a minimum fine of \$500.00 for knowingly operating or allowing the operation of a school bus without insurance.
2.	Adds a minimum fine of \$500.00 for the owner if a school bus is involved in an accident and is not covered by insurance.
3.	Makes a technical change.
4.	Adds that proposed law only applies to a school bus that is privately owned.

## **Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate**

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that a school bus driver knowingly operating a school bus without the required insurance shall be fined not less than \$500 nor more than \$1,000.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that if the owner of a school bus knowingly allows the school bus to be operated without the security required by <u>present law</u> he shall be fined not less than \$500 nor more than \$1,000.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that if a school bus operating without the security required by <u>present</u> <u>law</u> is involved in an accident, the owner shall be fined not less than \$500 nor more than \$1,000, the vehicle's registration will be revoked for 60 days, and the school bus driver's commercial driver's license privileges disqualified for 1 year, if he had knowledge that the bus was uninsured.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that <u>proposed law</u> only applies to a school bus that is privately owned.
