15 and Carla Ortega were regional champions and upset the top-seeded team to win the state  
16 doubles championship, and senior team member Caroline Fruge won the regional and state  
17 singles championship and finished the season with a 15-0 record; and

19 throughout the 2014 season, and each of these young ladies deserves recognition for her vital  
20 contributions to the winning effort; and
