2	To amend and reenact R.S. 13:5304(B)(10) and (K), relative to district courts' drug division
3	probation programs; to expand eligibility for participation in the drug division
4	probation program to defendants with certain prior felony convictions; to require that
5	drug division program evaluations shall include information on recidivism reduction
6	on participants; and to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 13:5304(B)(10) and (K) are hereby amended and reenacted to read
9	as follows:
10	§5304. The drug division probation program
11	* * *
12	B. Participation in probation programs shall be subject to the following
13	provisions:
14	* * *
15	(10) In order to be eligible for the drug division probation program, the
16	defendant must satisfy each of the following criteria:
17	(a) The defendant cannot have any prior felony convictions conviction for
18	any offenses offense defined as crimes of violence in R.S. 14:2(B) as a homicide in
19	<u>R.S. 14:29</u> .
20	(b) The crime before the court cannot be a crime of violence as defined in
21	R.S. 14:2(B), including domestic violence or an offense of domestic abuse battery
22	which is punishable by imprisonment at hard labor as provided in R.S. 14:35.3.
23	(c) Other criminal proceedings alleging commission of a crime of violence
24	as defined in R.S. 14:2(B) cannot be pending against the defendant.

2	(e)(d) The crime before the court cannot be a charge of driving under the
3	influence of alcohol or any other drug or drugs that resulted in the death of a person.

6	K. Each drug division shall develop a method of evaluation so that its
7	effectiveness can be measured. These evaluations shall be compiled annually and
8	transmitted to the judicial administrator of the Supreme Court of Louisiana and shall
9	include information on recidivism reduction on the participants in the program.
