<u>Proposed House Rule</u> retains the substance and effect of <u>present House Rule</u>. Amends <u>present House Rule</u> to reflect the consolidation of institutions formerly known as "Schools for the Blind", "Schools for the Deaf", and "Crippled Children's Schools" into the single successor classification "Special Schools" as provided in <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present House Rule</u> relative to referral of instruments to the House Committee on Health and Welfare features the term "mentally retarded".

<u>Proposed House Rule</u> amends <u>present House Rule</u> to delete the term "mentally retarded" and substitute therefor its successor clinical term "intellectual disability".
