## SENATE BILL NO. 38

## BY SENATORS MORRISH AND THOMPSON

AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 13:783(D)(7), relative to expenses of the clerks of court; to authorize an automobile expense allowance for the clerks of each district court; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
Section 1. R.S. 13:783(D)(7) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: §783. Expenses of clerk's office

(7) In Aeadia Parish, Bienville Parish, Bossier Parish, Caddo Parish, Cameron Parish, Claibome Parish, DeSoto Parish, East Felieiana Parish, Franklin Parish, Heria Parish, Lineoln Parish, Morehouse Parish, Natehitoches Parish, Ouachita Parish, Red River Parish, St. Charles Parish, St. Helena Parish, St. Landry Parish, St. Tanmany Parish, Tangipahoa Parish, Vermilion Parish, Washington Parish, Webster Parish, West Baton Rouge Parish, and West Feticiana Parish, the elerks of the distriet ourts of those parishes The clerk of each district court may receive an automobile expense allowance equal to fifteen percent of their annual salary provided the clerk of court maintains three hundred thousand dollars of automobile insurance per accident for bodily injury and one hundred thousand dollars of automobile insurance per accident for property damage. The expense

allowance shall come from surplus funds in each of the offices of the clerks of court and at no additional expense to the state or local governing authority.
