#### Abstract

AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 48:1456(D), relative to Capital Area Transit System; to provide for certain action relative to the board of commissioners; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published. Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: Section 1. R.S. 48:1456(D) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: §1456. Board of commissioners D. Notwithstanding the expiration of their terms, members shall serve until their successors are appointed and qualified, unless removed for cause, which removal shall take immediate effect. The governing authority of the appointing parish shall appoint a temporary replacement to the board immediately upon removal or within fourteen days. The temporary appointee shall remain on the board until a successor is appointed and qualified. A temporary appointee is not eligible for reappointment for a term. Members All other appointed members are eligible for reappointment.


Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
