
SENATE FLOOR AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Senator Thompson to Reengrossed House Bill No. 1115 by Representative Thompson

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 Delete Senate Committee Amendment Nos. 1 and 2 proposed by the Senate Committee on
3 Education and adopted by the Senate on May 26, 2014.

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 4, after "award;" delete the remainder of the line, delete lines 5 through 7,
6 and insert "to provide for alignment of such core curriculum with certain courses required
7 for high school graduation; and to provide for related matters."

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 5 and insert the following:

10 (b) For students who enter the ninth grade on or after July 1, 2014,
11 Government, AP US Government and Politics: Comparative, or AP US Government
12 and Politics: United States may be substituted for Civics as required by this Section
13 and shall satisfy the Civics and Free Enterprise instruction as a prerequisite to
14 graduation."

15 AMENDMENT NO. 4

16 On page 3, line 1, between "following:" and "Government" insert "Civics,"

17 AMENDMENT NO. 5

18 On page 3, at the end of line 3, change the comma "," to a period "."

19 AMENDMENT NO. 6

20 On page 3, delete lines 4 through 7

21 AMENDMENT NO. 7

22 On page 3, at the beginning of line 8, change "(dd)" to "(cc)"

23 AMENDMENT NO. 8

24 On page 3, line 11, between "Economics" and the period "." insert ", Economics, AP
25 Macroeconomics, or AP Microeconomics"
