1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 Page 1, line 2, after "Section 4.A" insert "and 4.B(1)"

4 Page 1, line 16, after "Section 4.A" insert "and 4.B(1)"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 7, between lines 20 and 21, insert:

7 "B.(1) After satisfaction of the requirements of Subsection A of this Section,
8 all remaining monies collected pursuant to this Act shall be paid into the state
9 treasury. After compliance with the requirements of Article VII, Section 9(B) of the
10 Constitution of Louisiana relative to the Bond Security and Redemption Fund and
11 prior to any monies being placed into the state general fund or any other fund, an
12 amount equal to the remaining collections shall be credited by the state treasurer as
13 follows:

14 (a) For Fiscal Year 2013-2014, the monies shall be credited to a special fund
15 hereby created in the state treasury to be known as the 2013 Amnesty Collections
16 Fund, hereinafter referred to as "fund". The monies in the fund shall be available for
17 appropriation for any public purpose in that fiscal year.

18 (b) For Fiscal Year 2014-2015:

19 (i) One hundred million dollars of such monies shall be credited to the fund
20 and shall be available for appropriation for any public purpose.

21 (ii) Of the monies in excess of one hundred million dollars, four million
22 dollars shall be appropriated to the Department of Economic Development to be
23 allocated to the Louisiana Regional Leadership Council to be used for purposes of
24 regional economic development and workforce development.

25 (iii) Any remaining monies after the allocations in Items (i) and (ii) of this
26 Subparagraph shall be credited to the fund and shall be available for appropriation
27 for any public purpose."
