SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Makes technical changes.

DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits the appointment of any person with an outstanding fine to the Board of Ethics to state or political subdivision boards or commissions.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "outstanding fines, fees, or penalties pursuant to the Code of Governmental Ethics" as a fine, fee, or penalty equal to an amount of \$250 or more for which all appeals have been exhausted.

Effective August 1, 2014.
