6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 42:2.1(C) and (D) are hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§2.1. Boards, commissions, councils, authorities, entities; composition

10	C. No person owing any outstanding fines, fees, or penalties pursuant to
11	the Code of Governmental Ethics shall be appointed to any board or
12	commission of the state or any political subdivision.
13	D. For purposes of this Section, "outstanding fines, fees, or penalties
14	pursuant to the Code of Governmental Ethics" shall mean a fine, fee, or penalty
15	equal to an amount of two hundred fifty dollars or more imposed by the Board
16	of Ethics for which all appeals have been exhausted.
