2	To amend and reenact R.S. 14:95(H), relative to carrying of weapons; to provide that
3	members and officers of the legislature may carry weapons; and to provide for

5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 14:95(H) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§95. Illegal carrying of weapons
8	* * *
9	H. The (1) Except as provided in Paragraph (A)(5) of this Section and in
10	Paragraph (2) of this Subsection, the provisions of this Section shall not prohibit
11	active justices or judges of the supreme court, courts of appeal, district courts, parish
12	courts, juvenile courts, family courts, city courts, federal courts domiciled in the state
13	of Louisiana, and traffic courts, members of either house of the legislature,
14	officers of either house of the legislature, constables, coroners, district attorneys
15	and designated assistant district attorneys, United States attorneys and assistant
16	United States attorneys and investigators, and justices of the peace from possessing
17	and concealing a handgun on their person when the justice or judge, legislator or
18	officer of the legislature, constable, coroner, district attorneys and designated
19	assistant district attorneys, United States attorneys and assistant United States
20	attorneys and investigators, or justices of the peace are certified by the Council on
21	Peace Officer Standards and Training Council.
22	(2) Nothing in this Subsection shall permit the carrying of a weapon in
23	the state capitol building.

25	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
