6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 38:2251(C)(3) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§2251. Preference for products produced or manufactured in Louisiana; exceptions

10	C. In addition to the requirements listed in Subsection B of this Section, the
11	following products shall meet the following specific requirements:

13	(3) Meat and meat products shall be processed in Louisiana from animals
14	which are alive at the time they enter the processing plant that originated in
15	Louisiana, as evidenced by traceability documentation supplied by the
16	manufacturer.

18	Section 2. R.S. 39:1595(C)(3) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
19	§1595. Preference for all types of products produced, manufactured, assembled,
20	grown, or harvested in Louisiana; exceptions

22	C. In order to qualify as Louisiana products for the purpose of this Section,
23	the following products shall meet the following requirements:

25	(3) Meat and meat products shall be processed in Louisiana from animals

4	Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
5	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
6	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
7	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
8	effective on the day following such approval.
