2	To amend and reenact R.S. 37:1218.1, relative to immunizations and vaccines; to provide
3	for the administering of immunizations and vaccines other than influenza
4	immunizations by a pharmacist; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 37:1218.1 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§1218.1. Administration of certain immunizations in primary care health
8	professional shortage areas and vaccines other than influenza
9	immunizations
10	A. In any parish designated wholly or in part as a primary care health
11	professional shortage area as set forth under Section 332 of the Public Health Service
12	Act, as determined by the United States Department of Health and Human Services,
13	a pharmacist may administer any of the following vaccines, but only in conformance
14	with the provisions of Subsection B of this Section:
15	(1) Pneumococcal, to any person eighteen years of age or older.
16	(2) Zoster, to any person fifty years of age or older.
17	B. The pharmacist shall administer each immunization in conformance with
18	the most current vaccination administration as set forth by the United States Public
19	Health Service Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices, following guidance
20	published in the Louisiana State Immunization Policies and Procedures Manual, to
21	participate in the program and to be covered by the National Vaccine Injury
22	Compensation Fund.

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ENROLLED

1	A pharmacist may administer to an individual age seventeen or older an
2	immunization or a vaccine without a patient-specific prescription or medical
3	order if the immunization or the vaccine is administered in conformance with
4	the most current immunization administration protocol as set forth by the
5	United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention Advisory Committee
6	on Immunization Practice. At the time that a pharmacist administers an
7	immunization or vaccine under the provisions of this Section, the pharmacist
8	shall also inform the individual that the administration of an immunization or
9	vaccine under this Section is not to be construed as being in lieu of an annual
10	checkup with the individual's primary care or family physician.
11	(1) The pharmacist shall report each immunization to the Department of
12	Health and Hospitals, office of public health's Louisiana Immunization Network for
13	Kids Statewide at the time of the immunization or as soon as reasonably practicable
14	thereafter, as this is the official state vaccination record.
15	(2) The pharmacist shall report all adverse events he observes or which are
16	reported to him to the Vaccine Adverse Events Reporting System, the cooperative
17	program of the United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the
18	United States Food and Drug Administration for vaccine safety, or its successor
19	program; and further, the pharmacist shall refer the patient with an adverse event to
20	an immunization for appropriate medical care.
21	(3) The pharmacist shall maintain for at least two years a record of each
22	immunization administered.
23	(4) The pharmacist shall obtain the appropriate credentials to administer
24	immunizations from the board, as administratively defined, prior to administering
25	any such immunization.
26	(5) The pharmacist shall request the name of a patient's primary care provider
27	prior to the administering of any immunization. If the patient identifies such primary
28	care provider to the pharmacist, the pharmacist shall notify the primary care
29	provider, by written or electronic communication, as soon as reasonably possible
30	thereafter that the immunization was administered.
