2	To enact R.S. 40:1300.264, relative to smoking near public and private elementary and
3	secondary school property; to prohibit smoking near certain property around public
4	and private elementary and secondary schools; to provide for certain exceptions; to
5	provide for marking of the smoke-free areas; to provide for penalties; to provide for
6	an effective date; and to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 40:1300.264 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	<u>§1300.264. Smoking prohibited near school property; exceptions; penalty</u>
10	A. Smoking, as defined in this Part, shall not be permitted, and no
11	person shall smoke within two hundred feet of the entrances, exits, or outdoor
12	areas of any public or private elementary or secondary school.
13	B.(1) This Section shall not apply to smoking by a person of the legal age
14	within private property that is within the two hundred feet boundary or to
15	smoking by a person of the legal age occupying a moving vehicle in which
16	smoking is not prohibited that is traveling through an area within the two
17	hundred feet boundary.
18	(2) This exception shall not apply to the property of a private elementary
19	or secondary school.
20	<u>C.</u> The state superintendent of education, with the approval of the State

1	Board of Elementary and Secondary Education, shall develop a method by
2	which to mark smoke-free areas, including the use of signs or other markings
3	suitable to the situation. Signs or other markings shall be located in a visible
4	manner on or near each school indicating that such area is a smoke-free area,
5	and that such an area is within two hundred feet of the entrances, exits, or
6	outdoor areas of any public or private elementary or secondary school. The
7	state Department of Education shall assist each school system with providing
8	for the posting required in this Subsection.
9	D.(1) Any violation of this Section may be cited by any law enforcement
10	officer by the issuance of a citation and summons to appear before a court of
11	proper jurisdiction.
12	(2) Such citations shall be in a form such that there shall be retained in
13	each book of citations a receipt and each shall have a copy to be deposited by
14	the law enforcement officer with a court having jurisdiction over the alleged
15	offense.
16	(3) Upon the deposit of the copy, the court shall notify the alleged
17	violator of the time and place of his hearing or of his opportunity to plead guilty
18	by the payment of his specified fine. Failure to appear, unless the fine is paid,
19	may be punished within the discretion of the court as contempt of court.
20	E.(1) Any person who is guilty of a violation of this Section shall, upon
21	a first offense, be fined twenty-five dollars.
22	(2) Any person who is guilty of violating this Section a second time shall
23	be fined fifty dollars.
24	(3) Any person who is guilty of violating this Section a third or
25	subsequent time shall be fined one hundred dollars.
26	F. The provisions of this Section shall not supersede the provisions of
27	<u>R.S. 40:1300.256(A).</u>
28	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
29	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
30	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
