## 1 AN ACT 2 To amend and reenact R.S. 42:1111(A)(4), relative to the Code of Governmental Ethics; to 3 increase the amount of supplemental compensation or benefits allowed to be 4 provided to an attorney who is a public employee who is participating in a certain 5 bona fide Loan Repayment Assistance Program; and to provide for related matters. 6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 7 Section 1. R.S. 42:1111(A)(4) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: 8 §1111. Payment from nonpublic sources 9 A. \* \* 10 \* 11 (4) Up to three five thousand dollars per year to be credited against qualified 12 student loan debt that is provided to a former law student who is an attorney and a 13 public employee through a bona fide Loan Repayment Assistance Program 14 established as a qualified program under the federal Internal Revenue Code and 15 administered by any law school using funds or property accruing to the benefit of the 16 law school or from a foundation which is organized specifically to aid and support 17 the programs of the law school and the charter of which specifically provides that the 18 purpose of the foundation is to aid the law school in a philanthropic manner shall be 19 deemed for purposes of this Subsection as a supplement to his compensation to 20 which he is duly entitled. However, such a supplement shall not be considered 21 regular compensation from the governmental entity which employs him, nor shall 22 it be the basis for governmentally supported benefits. 23

## **ENROLLED**

1	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
2	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
3	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
4	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
5	effective on the day following such approval.
