5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 44:4(48) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§4. Applicability
8	This Chapter shall not apply:
9	* * *
10	(48)(a) To security surveillance video of the capitol area and grounds or
11	to any images on security surveillance video of the capitol area and grounds
12	regardless of format.
13	(b) For purposes of this Paragraph, the phrase "capitol area and
14	grounds" shall mean the state capitol and the parking areas and grounds
15	immediately surrounding the state capitol, the capitol annex and the parking
16	areas and grounds immediately surrounding the capitol annex, and the
17	pentagon barracks buildings and the parking areas and grounds immediately
18	surrounding the pentagon barracks buildings.
19	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
20	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
