INSURANCE/HOMEOWNERS: Requests the Department of Insurance to study the issues of the availability and affordability of homeowners' insurance in coastal and intercoastal areas of the state

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

- 1. Deletes provisions for a task force to be utilized by the Department of Insurance in conducting the study.
- 2. Authorizes, rather than requires, the Department of Insurance to report the findings of its study to the House and Senate Committees on Insurance.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Harrison HCR No. 211

Urges and requests the Department of Insurance to conduct a study of the issues of the availability and affordability of homeowners' insurance in the coastal and intercoastal areas of the state, particularly in light of the recent enactment of a state uniform construction code, to report findings and recommendations to the legislative committees on insurance on or before Jan. 1, 2015.
