<u>Prior law</u> provided in the case of an emergency certificate issued pursuant to an examination conducted by telemedicine pursuant to <u>prior law</u>, a copy transmitted by facsimile or other electronic device shall be sufficient authority for the peace officer or ambulance worker to transport the patient to a treatment facility and for the director to accept such patient.

<u>New law</u> amends <u>prior law</u> to provide in the case of an emergency certificate issued pursuant to an examination conducted by telemedicine pursuant to <u>prior law</u>, or where the valid original is not provided to the transporter, a copy transmitted by facsimile or other electronic device shall be sufficient authority for the peace officer or ambulance worker to transport the patient to a treatment facility and for the director to accept such patient.
