Morrell (SB 204) Act No. 688

<u>Prior law</u> provided that all wine and distilled spirits sold or shipped into this state shall be in certain sized containers.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>prior law</u> and adds the following container sizes: nineteen and five-tenths liters, 20 liters, and 500 milliliters.

<u>Prior law</u> required that distilled spirits bottled subject to the standards provided for in <u>prior law</u> be packed with a certain number of bottles per shipping case or shipping container and further provides for the bottle size and the corresponding bottles per case.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>prior law</u> except that it changes all references <u>from</u> "bottles" <u>to</u> "containers" and further adds a container size of 100 milliliters with 48 containers per case.

<u>Prior law</u> required that wines bottled subject to the standards provided for in <u>prior law</u> be packed with a certain number of bottles per shipping case or shipping container and further provides for the bottle size and the corresponding bottles per case.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>prior law</u> except that it changes all references <u>from</u> "bottles" <u>to</u> "containers" and further changes a container size <u>from</u> 5 through 18 liters <u>to</u> 5 through 20 liters and adds a container size of 500 milliliters with 12 containers per case.

New law exempts cider products from container size restrictions.

<u>New law</u> prohibits the sale and shipment into this state of any containers of powdered alcohol.

Effective upon signature of the governor (June 18, 2014).
