1 A JOINT RESOLUTION 2 Proposing to amend Article IV, Section 1(B) of the Constitution of Louisiana, relative to 3 organization of the executive branch of state government; to provide for the 4 maximum number of departments in the executive branch of state government; to 5 provide for submission of the proposed amendment to the electors; and to provide 6 for related matters. 7 Section 1. Be it resolved by the Legislature of Louisiana, two-thirds of the members 8 elected to each house concurring, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the state of 9 Louisiana, for their approval or rejection in the manner provided by law, a proposal to 10 amend Article IV, Section 1(B) of the Constitution of Louisiana, to read as follows: 11 §1. Composition; Number of Departments; Reorganization 12 Section 1. 13 14 (B) Number of Departments. Except for the offices of governor and 15 lieutenant governor, all offices, agencies, and other instrumentalities of the executive branch and their functions, powers, duties, and responsibilities shall be allocated 16 17 according to function within not more than twenty twenty-one departments. Except 18 that no department may be created that has the powers, duties, and functions to 19 perform or administer programs or services which are historically performed or

administered by any other agency, office, or department of the state. The powers,

functions, and duties allocated by this constitution to any executive office or

1	commission shall not be affected or diminished by the allocation provided herein
2	except as authorized by Section 20 of this Article.
3	* * *
4	Section 2. Be it further resolved that this proposed amendment shall be submitted
5	to the electors of the state of Louisiana at the statewide election to be held on November 4,
6	2014.
7	Section 3. Be it further resolved that this proposed constitutional amendment shall
8	not become effective until funding is provided by the legislature, but no sooner than June
9	12, 2015.
10	Section 4. Be it further resolved that the department created by this amendment shall
11	be able to use federal funding under the provisions of Title 19.
12	Section 5. Be it further resolved that on the official ballot to be used at the election,
13	there shall be printed a proposition, upon which the electors of the state shall be permitted
14	to vote YES or NO, to amend the Constitution of Louisiana, which proposition shall read as
15	follows:
16	Do you support an amendment to change the maximum number of
17	departments in the executive branch of state government from twenty to
18	twenty-one? (Amends Article IV, Section 1(B))
