2	To amend and reenact R.S. 13:783(F)(7), relative to the payment of group insurance
3	premium costs for certain clerk of court employees; to require the clerks of court for
4	Bossier Parish, Caddo Parish, and Webster Parish to pay certain group insurance
5	premium costs; to provide for eligibility for payment of such costs; and to provide
6	for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 13:783(F)(7) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
9	§783. Expenses of clerk's office

13	(7) In the parishes of <u>Bossier, Caddo</u> , Caldwell, Franklin, Grant, LaSalle,
14	Webster, and Winn, the clerk of court shall pay, from the clerk's salary fund, one
15	hundred percent of the premium costs of the group life and accidental death and
16	dismemberment, group health, accident, dental, hospital, surgical, or other medical
17	expense insurance for any employee that retires from the Bossier Parish clerk of
18	court's office, the Caddo Parish clerk of court's office, the Caldwell Parish clerk of
19	court's office, the Franklin Parish clerk of court's office, the Grant Parish clerk of
20	court's office, the LaSalle Parish clerk of court's office, the Webster Parish clerk of
21	court's office, or the Winn Parish clerk of court's office who is entitled to receive
22	monthly benefits from the Louisiana Clerks' of Court Retirement and Relief Fund
23	who has at least twenty years of full-time service with the clerk of court's office in
24	Bossier Parish, Caddo Parish, Caldwell Parish, Franklin Parish, Grant Parish, LaSalle

AN ACT

1	Parish, Webster Parish, or Winn Parish, and who is at least fifty-five years of age.
2	The provisions of this Paragraph shall not apply to any other insurance, such as
3	supplemental insurance, that an employee may elect to purchase.
