<u>Existing law</u> establishes the Louisiana Procurement Code relative to purchasing by certain state agencies.

<u>New law</u> requires that when an agency covered by <u>existing law</u> purchases seats for public seating areas in state buildings following the renovation or construction of a state building, no fewer than 5% of the total seats purchased shall have arms.

New law exempts the following from the seat purchasing requirement:

- (1) Seating located in instructional spaces at public educational institutions.
- (2) Seating areas located in stadiums, coliseums, arenas, or similar buildings used as sport or entertainment venues.
- (3) Cafeterias or other food service areas.
