Part XVI of Chapter 2 of Title 33 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, to be comprised of R.S. 33:1420.21 is hereby enacted to read as follows: 9 PART XVI. SPECIAL DISTRICTS-MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS 10 11 §1420.21. Special districts; approval of actions by local governmental 12 subdivision 13 A. If the governing authority of a local governmental subdivision is also 14 the governing authority of a special district that the local governmental 15 subdivision created pursuant to state law or the local governmental subdivision's home rule charter and action of the governing authority of the 16 special district requires approval of the governing authority of the local 17 governmental subdivision, the action of the governing authority of the special 18 19 district and the approval by the local governmental subdivision may occur in 20 one meeting of the governing authority of the local governmental subdivision. 21 **B.** The provisions of this Section shall apply only when the members of 22 the governing authority of the local governmental subdivision and of the special 23 district are identical in number and in name. 24 C. Notwithstanding the provisions of this Section, the governing 25 authority of the local governmental subdivision and the governing authority of the special district shall independently follow any notice requirements 26 27 applicable to any actions taken by such entity.

1	D. As used in this Part, "local governmental subdivision" means a
2	<u>parish or municipality.</u>
3	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
4	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
5	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
6	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
7	effective on the day following such approval.
